General Meeting Agenda

The meeting called to order at 6:25pm (Meeting held at GYSC near concession stand)

President's Report- Aaron Kaminski

- Aaron announced that the Gilbert Soccer Club made a donation to the family of Rueben Hernandez, the 93 Santos Soccer Player that was killed in an auto accident in April. Additional private donations will be collected at Skills Assessment.
- GSC Arsenal 93 boys will play the Santos 93 Boys in a championship game on Saturday
- State Cup Results:
 - 90 Boys – 1st
 - 91 Boys – 1st or 2nd
 - 91 Girls – 4th
 - 92 Girls – 2nd
 - 93 Boys – 1st
 - 94 Girls – 4th
 - Five teams finished in 5th place
 - AYSA staff indicated that Gilbert parents were the most respectful on the sideline
- Skills Assessment the week of May 10 – May 17th. Team managers are expected to get volunteers to manage the registration table. We are expected to see over 1,000 kids to roll through the tryout process.
- Registration packets for AZ State League, Club registration, etc. will be delivered by our club registrar, Lisa Lenkaitis, sometime during skills assessment.
- Team Registration Day will be June 28th at Soccer Shack in Gilbert.
- Field Update – Aaron provided an overview of the improvements (around \$100K) being made to the GYSC fields during this summer. The fields will be closed from May until Labor Day to allow for these improvements. The same contractors that completed work at Reach 11 and Cap Basin will be doing the work at GYSC.
- Coach Compensation – Aaron discussed that the salary structure for the coaches' has been announced by the DOC to the coaching staff. This year, the teams will be fund into the club treasury. The club treasury will be responsible for paying the coach staff on a monthly basis. The process will likely start in August or September.
 - The logistics of how payments will be made and how the process will work will be analyzed and reviewed by a board appointed sub-committee. This sub-committee will report findings to the board in the next two months so that recommendations can be approved by the board and the process can be announced.
 - A treasurers meeting will be scheduled for August to review the process with the teams
- State League Meeting in April – The AYSA has decided to offer an Open league in addition to the Division 1/Division 2 format for state league. More details will follow before teams register.

- Motion passed by the board to spend up to \$2500 on chemical application for the GYSC fields with matching funds coming from GYSA.
- Motion passed by the board to provide up to 5 “player of the year” scholarships (3 from girls teams and 2 for boys teams) based on criteria developed from DOC and Bob Lawrence (immediate past president).
